

Joey of Windward HS got 96% on his last chemistry test, and Hannah of Milken HS scored 97% on her biology exam.


Paige of Harvard Westlake not only got straight A's 1st semester, but has been accepted to her dream school, the Wharton undergraduate college at U. Penn!

Summer Schedule Online

My summer schedule (2nd week of June – 3rd week of August) is now online. I will be available for office lessons on Tuesdays and weekends, and house calls on Thursdays. I am also planning to offer my first six-week LSAT course this summer! There will be no walk-in hours over the summer.

Inter-Agency Referral Policy

In exchange for a student referral from another tutor or agency, I will now offer a flat fee measured by two hours of lessons. For example, if a tutoring agency refers a student to me for office lessons at \$70 / hr, I will pay the agency \$140 for the referral. Then the student will be in my system.

When I refer a student to another tutor or agency, I will likewise ask for a referral fee worth two hours of lessons.

I'm afraid I am no longer available for part-time employment or private contracting through other agencies. I will still consider full-time offers with a tutoring agency that is able to guarantee steady work (12+ hours / week), especially in a high-end market such as college admissions, the SAT, LSAT, or bar exam.
