Set 2: Slow pace

Look at your entrance diagnostic score report. If your “Verbal Speed” score was high but your “Verbal Total” score was below 50%, then you will benefit from slowing down quite a bit so you can get more problems *right!*

You will do these problems at a “slow” pace. Set your timer to 25 minutes and be sure that you don’t get stuck for more than five minutes on any single problem. (Multiply that by the number of questions in a reading comp. passage, e.g. don’t spend more than 15 minutes on a three-question passage).

First, [watch this video](#) to understand how to address questions using my R-S-T-U system.

In this exercise set, I have already chosen ten questions and you will “address” all of them. You can mark each one:

- R (Right!)
- S (Skipped it because you don’t think you could ever get it right)
- T (Timed out at five minutes; maybe come back and look at it later)
- U (Unaddressed because your 25 minutes was up)

Remember not to leave any questions blank! Answer them even with random guesses.
