

# Week 1 Homework: Verbal Warmups

## *Ch. 4 (p. 53)*

Practice all problems in this chapter without worrying about time. Please don't do problems that aren't assigned.

Check your answers. If you get a problem wrong,

1. Look up any words you didn't know and try again.
2. If the book provides a solution, read it and make sure you understand why the right answer is right and why your answer was not the best choice.
3. If it is still not entirely clear to you, bring your questions to class for discussion next week. Have three questions ready in case someone else asks yours.

Do the Easy problems first, then Medium, then (optional) Hard

I don't particularly like p. 69 # 4, especially blank (ii). Maybe it makes more sense to you, but if not, don't sweat this one.

## *Entrance Diagnostic*

Revisit the verbal problems you got wrong on the entrance diagnostic. Time is not an issue.

The entrance diagnostic was p. 342 #'s 1, 3, 6, 10, 12, 17, 19, 21, 23, 25. Please don't do any other problems! I will be assigning other problems later, and it's important that you will be seeing them for the first time.

Please note that #'s 6 and 23 are ranked as "Hard" problems and therefore should be your last priority. Make sure you understand the rest of them first!
